### J. All Academic Team Certificate

All Academic Team Certificates for each sport.

### K. All Academic Individual Plaques

All Academic Awards shall be distributed following the sports season in which the athlete qualifies.

Athletes will be given All State academic recognition in the form of a trophy if they

1. Have a cumulative G.P.A. of 3.0 or better at the end of the quarter in which the majority of that sport season occurs,
  2. They have enrolled in and completed with a passing grade a minimum of 12 credits during the major quarter, and
  3. They meet the "Basis for Selection" for that sport as listed below.
- (All athletes who lettered, meeting 1 and 2 but not 3 will be given an All State academic certificate.

#### All Academic Awards

Shall be distributed following the sports season in which the athlete qualifies.

- a. Athletes will be given All State academic recognition in the form of a trophy if they;
  - 1) have a cumulative G.P.A. of 3.0 or better at the end of the quarter in which the majority of that sport season occurs,
  - 2) they have enrolled in and completed with a passing grade a minimum of 12 credits during that major quarter, and
  - 3) they meet the "Basis for Selection" for that sport as listed on the next page: (All athletes who lettered, meeting 1 and 2 but not 3, will be given an All State academic certificate.

Volleyball	32	Fall	Individuals from each of the All Division teams
Basketball	32	Winter	Individuals from each of the All Division teams
Football	48	Fall	Northern and Southern All-Conference Division teams, plus one kicker and punter from each division
Wrestling	30	Winter	First, second, and third individual place winners in each weight in the conference meet
Baseball	15	Spring	All-Conference Team
Softball	32	Spring	Individuals from each of the All-Division teams
Golf	8	Spring	Top 8 individuals from the MCCC meet
Tennis	27	Spring	First, second, and third individuals and doubles place winners in each flight at the MCCC meet

- b. An All Academic Team Certificate shall be given to the MCCC team that has the best G.P.A. of 3.0 or above during the majority season of participation. The following sport programs participate in this award: volleyball; women's basketball, and baseball.

Any player that drops below 12 credits at any time during the season of competition is ineligible to be counted in the team's average.
